Other Information:

1. Prom Photography is by School and Sport Pics. The photographer will be available from 8-11 pm. Students can have digital pictures taken at no additional charge.
2. Each prom couple, consisting of two people, must include at least one person who is a junior or a senior at Greenfield High School. If either person does not attend GHS, the guest permission slip must be completed. Guests must be 20 years or younger and may not be a middle school student.
3. Alcoholic beverages and smoking are **not** permitted at prom or post prom. Persons violating this rule will be removed from prom and ticketed by the police liaison. A breathalyzer device will be present and will be used if there is any suspicion of alcohol use. Bags and purses will be searched.
4. **Students must have a school ID to check in. If students wish to participate in the Grand March and Coronation, they must arrive by 6:30 p.m.** All students are expected to be seated for dinner by 7:15 p.m. Parents should decide when their students are expected at home. Once students leave the prom, they may not return.
5. The prom will be chaperoned by eight GHS staff members and their spouses.
6. Parents are welcome at the Grand March and Coronation, which will begin promptly at **6:30 p.m.** Students not attending the prom are **not** permitted at the Grand March unless accompanied by a parent. All spectators are asked to leave immediately after the Coronation so that dinner can be served.
7. Students may attend post prom whether or not they attend prom. Pre-registration is required. **No tickets to either event will be sold at the door.**
8. Students must check in to Post Prom by 12:45 a.m. Participants are encouraged to bring a casual change of clothes. Each participant will receive a t-shirt. Students must remain at Post Prom until the 3:30 a.m. dismissal time. **The only way students may leave early is if a parent comes to the venue to pick them up.**
9. A complete ticket application is required to purchase tickets. Forms are available in Room 239 and in the main office. Students 18 and older may sign for themselves, but should still include an emergency contact number (NOT a student cell phone number). No tickets will be sold at the door. **Please plan ahead!**
10. If a GHS student brings a guest who does not attend GHS, the attached guest permission slip must be completed, **including a copy of the guest's driver's license.** A background check will be conducted by our police liaison officer.
