EXAM EXEMPTIONS

Greenfield High School has an exam exemption program. The criteria for exam exemptions are:

1. Exam exemptions are available for students in grades 10, 11 and 12.
2. Only exams given during the scheduled two-hour exam period are eligible for exemption. Classes in which the semester exam is a performance based exam cannot be exempt.
3. The number of exemptions a student is eligible for is dependent on the grade level that they are in:
 - Sophomores can exempt one exam during the school year
 - Juniors can exempt two exams during the school year
 - Seniors can exempt three exams during the school year
4. Yearlong classes can only be exempted 2nd semester. Semester classes could be exempted either semester.
5. A student must earn an “A” [90%] or better average for each quarter of a semester in the class to be exempt in order to qualify. A grade of B+ or lower excludes a student from an exemption.
6. A student is allowed a maximum of 2 tardies from the class to be exempt.
7. A student is not allowed any truancies from the class to be exempt.
8. A student is allowed a maximum of 2 unexcused absences from the class to be exempt.
9. ANY out of school suspensions during the semester will disqualify a student from exemptions in ALL classes.
10. Students must have permission form signed by their parent/guardian, the teacher of the class, and an administrator to be exempt.

** Advance Placement students who take the national exam do not have to take the final exam in that class provided they are receiving a C or better (Semester grade) at the time of the final exam.
