Application for Student Parking Permit

1. Student parking permits are required during school hours. The cost of an annual parking permit is \$100.00. The permit should be obtained during school registration week. Permits are issued for (1) vehicle only. All types of vehicles require a permit. Motorcycles, mopeds, etc...
2. Your parking permit must be VISIBLY DISPLAYED AT ALL TIMES. Students without properly displayed parking permits will be ticketed by the Greenfield Police Department. Improperly parked vehicles will also be ticketed.
3. Students reported as driving recklessly or at an excessive speed may be ticketed by the police and will lose the privilege of parking in the lot. Speed limit is 10 miles per hour.
4. Excessive tardiness, truancy, skipping class and other infractions are grounds for revoking a student's parking privilege. Specifically, students who use vehicles to leave school without proper authorization will result in the loss of parking permit and fees paid. This includes students who leave campus without prior authorization during the lunch hour, or any other time.
5. During the 2nd semester a reduced price parking pass will be available for \$50.00. All school rules governing parking passes will apply to this pass as well. It is non-transferable, there are no refunds.
6. Students must provide proof of insurance on the vehicle being parked per Board Policy #5515.
