

HUSTLIN' HAWKS ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB

Scholarship/Hawk Award guidelines to be used by the scholarship committee

1. Students must have been an active participant in an athletic activity for each of the four years at GHS. Transfer students must show proof of involvement at the previous school.
2. Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 at the end of the 1st semester of their Senior year for the general Scholarship. There is no minimum GPA required for the Hawk Award.
3. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) or students must have been involved in Athletic Booster Club activities for a minimum of 40 hours at time of application (with preference being a minimum of 10 hours for each of 4 years.)
4. Students must be pursuing secondary education at a college, university, vocational or technical school upon graduation from GHS and provide proof of acceptance or enrollment.
5. Four (4) Scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$500 each; Two male athletes and/or team managers and two female athletes and/or team managers if sufficient acceptable applications are submitted by each gender. Athletes and/or team managers that meet the criteria as stated on the application may apply.

Points are awarded for athletic participation and GPA. Athletic Booster Club volunteer hours must meet the minimum required 40 hours for the student to qualify to apply for this scholarship. Only in case of a tie in students' points are volunteer hours beyond 40 taken into consideration.

7. Two (2) Hawk Awards will be awarded in the amount of \$500 each to the top two athletes and/or team managers; one male and one female if applications are submitted by both genders. **Coaches must nominate the athlete and/or team manager.**

Points are awarded for athletic participation, GPA (although no minimum is required to apply), and citizenship. Athletic Booster Club volunteer hours must meet the minimum required 40 hours for the student to qualify to apply for this scholarship. Only in case of a tie in students' points are volunteer hours beyond 40 taken into consideration.

8. Only one Scholarship OR Hawk Award per student.
9. Should there be an insufficient number of qualified applicants by the deadline date, the committee may choose one of the following options (in no particular order):
 - a. Choose to distribute the scholarship/awards to any qualified applicant regardless of gender.
 - b. Adjust the amounts of the scholarships/awards.
 - c. Seek advisement from the Athletic Booster Club Board as to the distribution.
